


Mizoram Tourism: Over 22,000 ILPs issued in the last four months Tourist inflow increases after the opening of Sairang

New Delhi,Agency: More than 22,000 Inner Line Permits (ILPs) have been issued since the inauguration of the Bairabi-Sairang railway line in Mizoram, police said.

Since the Bairabi-Sairang railway line was inaugurated in September last year, more than 22,000 Inner Line Permits (ILPs) have been issued at the Sairang railway station. A police officer posted at the ILP counter at Sairang station said that a total of 20,914 ILPs were issued to tourists, businessmen and migrant workers from September 13, 2025, after the railway line's inauguration, until the end of last year. An additional 1,517 ILPs were issued between January 1 and 8, bringing the total to 22,431. He added that on average,



around 100-200 ILPs are issued every time a train arrives at the station. "Typically, two trains arrive daily,"

The people who came in October and November were tourists

He said most visitors, especially in October and November, were tourists, while the December

influx was dominated by migrant workers and traders.

However, on some occasions, violators were apprehended who tried to escape from the police station.

Some beggars were also traced, who were immediately sent back to their native villages. Tourists generally come from various

states, including Delhi, West Bengal, and southern states, with the largest number coming from neighboring Assam. The police admitted they are facing a severe staff shortage, as they are currently performing the duties of the Government Railway Police (GRP) in addition to maintaining law and order and managing ILP verification. Speaking on condition of anonymity, the officer said, "Although the GRP hasn't been formally notified yet, we still perform their duties, including traffic and parking control. The staff shortage is a challenge, especially when 1,500-2,000 passengers arrive at a time." Currently, the station has 20 policemen, who sometimes work until 2 a.m. due to train delays and return to duty at 7 a.m.

Mahua Moitra carried by cops outside Amit Shah's office as protest against ED raids blows up

Odisha,Agency: Several courts in Odisha were put on high alert after receiving anonymous threatening emails. Security agencies responded immediately, intensifying investigations, and deployed special teams to prevent any untoward incidents. Khilari Rishikesh Gyandev said on Thursday that special bomb disposal squads, search teams, and additional security teams have been deployed as per standard operating procedures. He said, "A tip-off was received from a security perspective, and since this is a sensitive matter, standard security drills are being carried out as per protocol to thoroughly check the premises. Security agencies are continuing inspections as part of the drill." He further said that inspections are ongoing and officials are assessing the threat, so further information is awaited. New Delhi,Agency: Ahead of the Maharashtra civic polls, the State Election Commission on Friday announced a public holiday for January 15 in areas under 29 municipal corporations where polling will be held. The public holiday will be applicable to government and semi-government offices, corporations, boards, public undertakings, banks and central government offices within the jurisdiction of the civic bodies, news agency reported. The commission also informed that preparations related to the polls, including the readiness of EVMs (electronic voting machines), have been completed.

Union Agriculture Minister holds bilateral meeting with Fijian counterpart to deepen India-Fiji cooperation in the agriculture sector

Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan, held a bilateral meeting with Hon. Tomasi Tunabuna, Minister for Agriculture and Waterways of Fiji, at Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi on 9th January 2026. Both the sides discussed ongoing cooperation and outlined future areas of collaboration. Hon'ble Minister highlighted that India enjoys historical relations with Fiji which is growing further on mutual respect, cooperation and strong cultural and people-to-people ties. He further underscored that both countries recognise the significance of agriculture and food security as key areas for bilateral cooperation. Both Ministers held a fruitful discussion on a broad range of issues of mutual interest. The two sides agreed to extend the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for a further five years and to establish a Joint Working Group (JWG) to advance cooperation. In addition to this the key areas of collaboration discussed included student exchanges, training and capacity-building programmes, and technology sharing covering small-scale machinery, and digital agriculture tools. The discussions also focused on strengthening research infrastructure, genetic exchange initiatives and knowledge sharing on reducing food loss and waste.

No personal objection to merger of 2 NCPs, but decision must be collective: Sunil Tatkare

Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar, Agency: NCP state president Sunil Tatkare on Thursday said he had no personal objection to a possible merger decision of the two

NCP factions, but added any such move would have to be taken collectively by the party brass. His statement came against the backdrop of the two NCPs forming an alliance for municipal corpora-

tion elections in some places. Tatkare said the decision to align with NDA had been discussed within the party for several years, but was repeatedly deferred.
