## SC defers hearing on Hawara's plea for transfer to Punjab jail

NEW DELHI, JANUARY 13

The Supreme Court on Tuesday deferred hearing on former Chief Minister Beant Singh murder convict Jagtar Singh Hawara's plea seeking his transfer from Tihar jail to a prison in Punjab by two weeks.

Hawara — a Babbar Khalsa terrorist — is serving life term in the case related to the assassination of former CM Beant Singh in 1995.

A Bench of Justice MM Sundresh and Justice N Kottiswar Singh adjourned the hearing as Solicitor General Tushar Mehta was not available.

The 55-year-old prisoner has sought his transfer to a Punjab jail on grounds that he demonstrated good conduct in jail, the crime was committed at a time of social unrest and his daughter lived in Punjab. He has contended that all co-accused involved in the jail break were in Punjab jails and the Director General (Prisons) recommended his transfer to a jail in Punjab almost eight years ago on October 7, 2016. He also claimed that

there was not a single case pending against him in Delhi and that he was unable to attend proceedings in a case pending in Punjab.

Former CM Beant Singh and 16 others were killed on August 31, 1995, in an explosion outside the Civil Secretariat in Chandigarh on August 31, 1995. Hawara was arrested on September 21, 1995.

A special CBI court had awarded the death sentence to Balwant Singh Rajoana and Jagtar Singh Hawara in 2007 while co-accused Lakhwinder Singh, Gurmeet Singh and Shamsher Singh were sentenced to life imprisonment for hatching a conspiracy to assassinate the former CM.

However, the Punjab and Haryana High Court in October 2010 modified Hawara's sentence to life imprisonment for the rest of his life and the prosecution's appeal against the high court's order was pending in the Supreme Court. Rajoana's mercy petition has been hanging fire for more than 12 years.

The top court had on September 27, 2024, issued notice to the Centre and governments of Delhi and Punjab on his petition seeking his transfer from Tihar Jail in Delhi to a jail in Punjab.

Hawara, who escaped from high security Baurail jail on January 22, 2004, was re-arrested after a year. "Petitioner (Hawara) had 36 false cases foisted on him after the murder of former CM Beant Singh. He has been acquitted in all, except one case. He is unable to attend the court proceedings on account of his incarceration in Delhi. He is not being produced in the court and the proceedings are going on without him which is prejudicial to the Petitioner..." he submitted.

## Parties to set ball rolling for '27 poll at Maghi Mela today

AAP puts up largest tent, show of strength by Akali Dal & BJP, too

With mercury dipping to 0.6 degrees Celsius, the political temperature is set to soar on Wednesday as the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) rolls out the largest pandal for its Maghi Mela rally in Muktsar over-shadowing rival parties Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD), Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and splinter Akali groups — Akali Dal (Waris Punjab De) and SAD (Amritsar).

The mudslinging is expected to fly thick and fast as the model code of conduct would be in place by this time next year. AAP has mounted what many are calling the biggest political setup seen in the past few decades. The party has cleared wheat crop on around 25 acres along Muktsar-Kotkapura Road to raise a sprawling venue.

AAP's Muktsar district chief Jashan Brar said the party expected 60,000 to 70,000 supporters. "Around 1,600 buses are coming from across Punjab. The rest will come in cars and other vehicles," he said. AAP national convener Arvind Kejriwal, Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann, cabinet ministers and MLAs are

expected to address the gathering. Many in the party hint at a major announcement to be made from the stage.

In contrast, SAD, historically dominant at the mela, has retained the conventional Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC) ground venue on Malout Road, setting up a tent on 2.5 five acres. SAD's district head Kanwarjit Singh Rozy Barkandhi said, "Over 12,000 chairs have been put up and the expected attendance lies between 18,000 and 20,000."

For the first time, the BJP is holding a solo Maghi Mela rally after the end of its alliance with the Akalis. "A

180x240 ft tent has come up in saffron and green on Malout Road, with arrangements for around 4,000 chairs. A turnout of at least 10,000 workers is expected. Several national and state leaders of the party, including Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini, Union MoS Ravneet Singh Bittu, former Union Minister Anurag Thakur, national general secretary Tarun Chugh, state chief Sunil Jakhar and state's working president Ashwani Sharma are scheduled to address the gathering," said BJP leader Puspinder Bhandari.

The Akali Dal (Waris Punjab De), which was formed at the mela last year, is holding an open-air rally over roughly 20,000 sq ft on Malout Road. Party coordinator Paramjit Singh Johal said, "We are expecting 7,000 to 8,000 supporters." Their hoardings feature jailed Khadoor Sahib MP Amritpal Singh behind prison bars. Besides, the photos of party's Faridkot MP Sarabjeet Singh Khalsa, Jaswant Singh Khalsa, Deep Sidhu and Jarnail Singh Bhindranwale have been put up on hoardings.

The SAD (Amritsar) will hold its rally at Dera Bhai Mastan Singh Road. Meanwhile, the Congress is not holding rally citing the edict issued by Akal Takht in 2017 refraining the political parties from holding rallies during such occasions, and plans to hold a rally after the Maghi.

The administration along with Harpal Tiwana's Foundation is organising a play, 'Mittar Pyare Nu', based on the martyrdom of younger sons of Guru Gobind Singh, at Guru Gobind Singh Park here in the evening. Besides, a 'Team Insaaf' of youngsters is holding a march, demanding legalisation of poppy cultivation in the state.

## Illegal mining turns fatal as truck driver drowns in Sutlej

A tipper truck driver lost his life after the vehicle he was driving fell into a ditch on the banks of Sutlej River near Nangran village. According

to the information, he was on his way to collect illegally mined material.

The victim, Yakub Ali, a 27-year-old resident of Hayatpur, Nurgpur Bedi, worked for

stone crusher operators. Around 3.30 am, he drove his tipper into the riverbed but failed to notice the ditch carved out of the riverbed for mining activity in the dark-

ness. The tipper plunged into the pit. The contractors managed to recover the truck, but Yakub had died by the time. His body was later abandoned at a hospital. —TNS

# SIT visits SGPC head office

of Akal Takht were supreme and the SGPC was fully committed to complying with these in letter and spirit.

wherever sought by the police so that the truth could come out and a fair investigation could be ensured. He reiterated that the SGPC would act with transparency and responsibility in this sensitive matter to maintain the trust of the Sikh sangat. —TNS

## Akal Takht reschedules time of CM's meet on Jan 15

In a bizarre turn of events, Akal Takht's officiating Jathedar, Giani Kuldeep Singh Gargaj, has rescheduled a meeting with Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Singh Mann at the Akal Takht secretariat, citing the CM's prior appointments. However, the CM clarified via X that he was ready to attend at the original 10 am time on January 15.

On January 5, the Jathedar had called up the CM at the Akal Takht secretariat at 10 am on January 15 to submit clarification over allegedly "insulting" the Sikh principles and institutions through his conduct in the past.

The CM's appointment at the Akal Takht secretariat coincides with the visit of the President of India Droupadi Murmu who has to attend two convocation ceremonies as chief guest in Amritsar on January 15 and in Jalandhar the next day. The Akal Takht secretariat today issued a let-

ter changing the meeting time to 4.30 pm.

"You were called up at 10 am to submit your clarification, but due to your prior occupation as expressed by you in your statements, you have to report at the Akal Takht secretariat at 4.30 pm on January 15," the letter reads.

The CM responded, "I have no appointment on January 15. I have conveyed this to the office of the President. January 15, as per your orders, was fully devoted to the Akal Takht. No official intimation about changing the time from me or my office was released. I am ready to come humbly at 10 am."

As the protocol would have it, the CM was to accompany the President of India who has been scheduled to visit Guru Nanak Dev University (GNDU), Amritsar, for the 50th Golden Jubilee Convocation on January 15 and Dr BR Ambedkar National Institute of Technology (NIT) Jalandhar for its 21st Convocation Ceremony on January 16.
