## Fear Grips Residents Due to Menace of Stray Bulls

**Mukundgarh.** The menace of stray bulls in the town is escalating day by day. Bulls roaming the markets, bus stands, main intersections, and public spaces have become a major source of trouble and danger for the general public. Often, these bulls clash with each other and wander into crowded areas, leaving pedestrians, shopkeepers, and motorists in constant fear of injury or property damage. Locals report numerous instances where people have narrowly escaped injury during these fights. Shoppers-particularly women and children-face significant difficulties. Despite this, no permanent solution has been found so far. Traders and residents have urged the municipality and the administration to



take effective measures promptly, rather than waiting for a major accident to occur. They advocate for relocating the stray animals to a safe area and establishing proper management systems to provide relief to the townspeople. Citizens believe that swift action on issues of public interest is the hallmark of a responsible administration.

## Birsa Munda's descendants allege neglect, apathy by govt authorities

**New Delhi, Agency:** Birsa Munda, the celebrated tribal leader and freedom fighter, spearheaded a major 19th-century uprising against British colonial rule. He mobilised indigenous communities to fight for their land rights, culture and self-determination, leaving behind a lasting legacy in Indian history.

The Narendra Modi government has designated November 15, Birsa Munda's birth anniversary, as 'Janjatiya Gaurav Divas' to honour the contributions of India's tribal communities to the freedom struggle and cultural heritage.

Miles away, in Jharkhand's Khunti district, lives the tribal icon's great-great-grandson Kanhu Munda. A postgraduate working at the local sub-divisional magistrate's office, he says few care about how the family of the tribal icon makes ends meet.

"Political leaders cutting across party lines have capitalised on the name of Birsa Munda without doing anything concrete about his family. Our ancestors fought for the freedom of this beautiful land, but most of us are landless. Our children do not go to good schools. We do not have pucca houses," he told The Tribune in an exclusive interaction. Kanhu lost his elder brother Mangal Munda in a car accident in 2024. "We had to rush him to Ranchi because our village did not have better medical facilities. We lost him during treatment," he said.

He said President Droupadi Murmu, Prime Minister Modi and several central and state leaders had visited his house in Ulihatu village.

"For long, we have been requesting both central and



state dispensations for better school and medical facilities in the village. Even in this 21st century, we are centuries behind the mainstream society. At least, our next generation should move forward with better education, health and opportunities," he argued. Kanhu said several stadiums, universities, schools and colleges had been named after Birsa Munda, but the icon's own descendants remained out of these institutions.

"The government should at least give us some kind of royalty, or financial aid to our children to study. We are the last surviving family belonging to Bhagwan Birsa Munda, and expect little more consideration from the authorities," he said.

Prime Minister Modi inaugurated the Bhagwan Birsa Munda Museum and Memorial Park in Ranchi district in 2021. The Rs 35-crore project features a 25-foot statue and details the struggles of several tribal leaders against British rule.

The tribal icon's great-great-grandson, however, said the government should instead work on creating supporting infrastructure around the museum, including hotels, food joints, better roads and connectivity, to attract tourists.



## I was denied hotel accommodation in Maharashtra over 'Kashmiri identity', alleges BJP's J&K neta

**Srinagar, Agency:** BJP's media in-charge in J&K, Sajid Yousuf Shah, has alleged that he was denied accommodation at a hotel in Maharashtra's Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj on Saturday because of his Kashmiri identity. "An hour after I checked into a hotel in Aurangabad, I was asked to leave due to concerns linked to my Kashmiri identity. The owner was courteous and candid. He acknowledged that the decision was unfair and hurtful but said he was following instructions," Shah wrote on social media on Saturday evening.

"For decades, countless Kashmiris have worked to strengthen the bonds between Jammu & Kashmir and the rest of India. Most Indians have welcomed us with warmth and respect. Yet incidents like this show that stereotypes and apprehensions persist," he said.

"My faith in India and its people remains unshaken. I hope we continue moving toward a future where no citizen is judged by their region, faith, or identity, but by their character and conduct. That is the India we must strive for," Shah said.

## NTA releases city intimation slip for aspirants

**New Delhi, Agency:** The National Testing Agency (NTA) has released the city intimation slip for the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test Undergraduate (NEET-UG) 2026, which will be conducted on June 21.

Candidates who have registered for the NEET-UG 2026 can now log in to official portal to view and download the city intimation slip. The document is aimed at helping students make necessary travel and accommodation arrangements well before the examination.

The NTA has clarified that the city intimation slip is not the admit card and should not be treated as permission to enter the examination hall. The slip only informs candidates about the city in which their examination centre has been allotted.

## BJP to kick off Punjab poll outreach with Nitin Nabin, Union ministers' visits

**New Delhi, Agency:** The BJP is set to roll out its Punjab election campaign from this month, with several high-profile visits by party leaders lined up.

Top sources confirmed to The Tribune that BJP president Nitin Nabin will pay his maiden visit to Punjab in June, tentatively around the end of the month. He is expected to visit Amritsar and begin the tour by paying obeisance at the Golden Temple and the Durgiana Mandir. Ahead of Nabin's visit, the party is lining up tours of two senior Union ministers to Punjab.

The first to arrive will be Union Urban Affairs and Housing Minister Manohar Lal Khattar. "A June 13 visit is



being finalised for ML Khattar, who will come to Amritsar," sources said.

Union Law Minister Arjun Ram Meghwal is also expected to visit the state within the next few days. Following these ministerial visits, the BJP plans to draft several other senior ministers for its Punjab election outreach campaign. The plan follows meetings held by BJP Punjab chief Kewal Singh Dhillon with several Union ministers, during which he urged a proactive role by the Central Government in addressing what he termed as "Punjab's multiple challenges."

## Zojila Tunnel set for June 9 breakthrough; how it will ensure all

**New Delhi, Agency:** The Zojila Tunnel Project, one of India's most ambitious and challenging infrastructure undertakings, is set to achieve a major milestone with its final breakthrough scheduled for June 9. The breakthrough marks a defining moment in the construction of the 13.153-km Zojila Tunnel, which, upon

completion, will become the world's longest single-tube bi-directional road tunnel at the highest altitude. Situated at an elevation of around 11,578 feet above sea level in the rugged Himalayas, the tunnel connects Baltal near Sonamarg in Jammu and Kashmir with Meenamarg in the Drass-Kargil region of Ladakh.

**New Delhi, Agency:** Nepal has ruled out third-party mediation in the border dispute with India, saying the issue will be resolved through existing diplomatic mechanisms between the two countries. Following Nepal PM Balendra Shah's remarks last week urging the UK to take an interest in the dispute, India had said there's no place for mediation by any third country on the issue. Visiting Nepal foreign minister Shisir Khanal said Sunday Shah was seeking historical records, not mediation, from the UK when he made those remarks.
